

Graduation Tips for Seniors

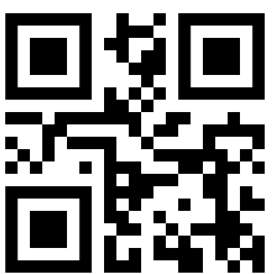


- Graduates and parents/caregivers will get weather messages through our Thrillshare system. You can also check our social media pages for updates regarding weather for that day.
- In the event of an Indoor Ceremony, graduates will report to the East Gym to assemble for the procession to the ceremony in the West Gym.
- In the event of an Outdoor Ceremony, graduates will report to the West Gym (where we held rehearsals) to assemble for the procession to the athletic field.
- Graduates must arrive by 6:30 pm with their cap (may be already on) and carrying their gown. We will have some bobby pins to assist in securing your cap if necessary.
- Please consider the occasion when planning your attire for this formal event. Please do not come to campus dressed in your gowns.
- Caps must be decorated in good taste. The administration will reserve the right to confiscate any cap and will provide an alternative cap.

- The Indoor Ceremony will be held in the West Gym (closest to the digital sign).
- The Outdoor Ceremony will be held on the athletic field enclosed in the gated area of the track.
- The Graduation Ceremony will begin promptly at 7:15 pm.

- The Laurie Kunzle Performing Arts Center (in the East Building) will be streaming the ceremony. There are no tickets for the auditorium seating as it is first come first serve.
- The Indoor Ceremony (in the West Gym) has very limited seating. Tickets are required for children if they can't stay seated on your lap.
- There are reserved seating for folks who need accessible seating and reserved seating for other honorees. Please don't remove any signage or seat reservation cards. General seating are the bleacher areas.
- Large balloons and posters (i.e, Fatheads®, cutouts on sticks, custom large signage) are not permitted. Please be courteous to the guests around you.
- Please do not set up cameras during the ceremony, walk on the football field, or block the gymnasium aisles to take pictures as they detract from others' views.
- In the event of an indoor ceremony. We will be providing students and parents/caregivers the opportunity to pick up diplomas on Thursday, June 22nd from 7:30 am to 2:30 pm and again the week of Monday, June 26th. Diplomas will not be handed out after the ceremony in the case of an indoor ceremony.
