CALL TO ORDER	Chair Huttle called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.
PREPARE FOR PRESENTATION	Board members and Superintendent Lotze reviewed the handout for the public presentation which included a draft four-day school week calendar and a comparison of the current 5-day vs. 4-day proposed schedule.
PUBLIC PRESENTATION— 6:30 pm @ Cutter Theatre Auditorium 17-18 Planning—4 Day School Week Possibility	Superintendent Lotze presented a four-day school week option to approximately 70 people and then held a question and answer session on the topic. Attendees also had the opportunity to complete a survey at the end of the session. 100% of the returned surveys were supportive of the district moving to a four-day week. The survey and supporting information is also available on the district website.
PUBLIC COMMENT	Questions from parents included times regarding daily schedule, calendar, athletics, homework, and busing.
BOARD DISCUSSION	The board, Superintendent Lotze and Principal Greg Goodnight reconvened at the elementary school to continue the discussion of a four-day school week application process. Based on the positive community support, Superintendent Lotze will submit a resolution for the board's consideration at the next monthly meeting on February 28.
ADJOURNMENT	Chair Huttle adjourned the meeting at 8:46 p.m.
