CLASSROOM RULES:

1. Show respect to yourself and to others.
2. Bring all necessary materials (pocket folders (green), pencil bags, iPads, reading notebook and a free reading book) to class with you every day.
3. NO FOOD OR DRINK IS ALLOWED unless specified by me.
4. You will need to use the restroom and get drinks before entering the room between classes.
5. If we finish a lesson early, you are expected to pull out a free reading book and read or work on Core 5 on the iPad. You will not be allowed to bring any unfinished work into the classroom unless we are having study hall on Fridays.
6. Follow all student handbook rules.
7. Come in excited to learn and ready to do your best!

GRADING:

80% of your grade will be summative assessments. Examples include:

- Assessments at the end of each learning unit
- Large projects

20% of your grade will be formative work. Examples include:

- Weekly skills practice worksheets

LATE WORK

All work is DUE on the specified DUE DATE. If your work is not completed at that time, it will be late and you will be placed on the ICU list until it is complete and handed in. As soon as it is graded, you will be taken off the ICU list. You always have ESR II you may attend to make up work also.

SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENTS

If you do poorly on a summative task, you will have the opportunity to retake the test ONE time only for a better grade. You will only have this opportunity after remediation has occurred. The second score will then be recorded as the final grade.

ABSENCES DUE TO ILLNESS:

Our GFL policy states that work will be recorded as “late due to absence.” This will be recorded on the ICU list and will be removed once the assignment or test is completed. If you choose not to complete work by the end of the quarter, it will be replaced with a “zero.”

EXCUSED/SCHOOL RELATED ABSENCES:

If you know in advance you are going to be gone, it is the expectation that you notify me before the day of the absence to get any work you will miss and have it done upon arrival back to school. This is best practice and will prevent you from falling behind.

CLASSROOM PROCEDURES:

1. Please come into the classroom quietly, sit in your assigned seat and show me you're ready to go. The lesson for the day will be posted on the board.
2. You will have a 90 minute reading session daily. The **first** ½ will be working on weekly skill development through the Reading Street curriculum or our Core 5 reading program. You will also have a quarterly AR reading goal you can work on at this time. The **second** ½ of the class will either be small or whole group instruction with Mrs. Bailey's class. This will be continued skill development working on reading fluency and comprehension.
3. Be an active learner! You should sit in reading position, ready to learn. You will have many opportunities to share your ideas and contribute to classroom discussion. You should also show respect to others' contributions and be a good listener.
4. Remain focused and positive. Your goal is to become a better reader! Give me your best EVERY DAY!!
