A REPORT FROM COLUMBUS U.S.D. #493 JULY 30, 2020 SPECIAL BOARD MEETING

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The board recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

ADOPT AGENDA AS PRESENTED

The board voted to adopt the agenda as presented.

APPROVE COVID-19 RELATED ACCOUNTS PAYABLE

The board voted to approve the district COVID-19 pandemic related expenses due and payable in the amount of \$42,491.11 as presented.

FY21 BUDGET PREPARATION

Brian Smith presented the proposed district budget as prepared. He reported the mill levy for the district will drop slightly and that the county assessed valuation did not climb as anticipated. The budget hearing will be held August 10, 2020 before the regular monthly board meeting.

CUHS ART BUILDING DEMOLITION

Brian Smith reported on the status of obtaining bids on the proposed demolition of the CUHS art building and necessary dirt work involving utilities.

RE-OPENING SCHOOLS PLAN

Brian Smith shared the draft Crisis Mitigation: COVID-19 Exposure Prevention, Preparedness, and Response Plan for Education Institutions. The County Commissioners will discuss the Governor's student mask ruling at a meeting next Monday.

The board voted to accept the resignation of Donna Hawkins as TLC Bus Driver.

The board voted to hire Caleb Linn as Highland Third Grade Teacher.
