### **DISTRICT TRANSPORTATION RULES AND REGULATIONS**

Every day our priority is to transport students safely to and from their school campuses. Please take a few minutes to review the safety and student conduct expectations below with your child for MISD bus and district-owned vehicle transportation.

#### **MORNING ROUTES:**

- Please check your child for symptoms of illness before arriving at the bus stop
- All students will be temperature scanned before boarding.
  - **Students found to have a temperature of 100.5 or higher will not be permitted to board the vehicles.** For this reason, we ask that a parent/guardian stay with your student until you are sure they pass the screening and can board the vehicle.

#### **ALL ROUTES:**

- **ALL** students, regardless of age, must wear a face covering or mask while riding in district-owned vehicles.
- Students will be assigned seats (by family group on AM/PM school buses)
- Vehicles will be sanitized at the conclusion of each use.

**STUDENT RULES ON DISTRICT OWNED VEHICLES:** District transportation should be considered an extension of the classroom and students are expected to behave accordingly. Students being transported in school-owned vehicles should comply with the Student Code of Conduct and Student Handbook. Misconduct will be punished in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct. The privilege to ride in a district vehicle, including a school bus, may be suspended or revoked.
