

GRADE ORGANIZATION

The Selkirk School District has instructional levels grades kindergarten through twelve. The grouping and housing of the instructional levels in school facilities shall be according to plans developed by the Superintendent and approved annually by the board.

The administration shall give special consideration for the emotional needs and development of students housed in multi-grade buildings to insure unsupervised interaction between the oldest and youngest students in each building are minimized. Building-level Advisory Councils will review grade organization annually and make recommendations to the building principal. The principal will report to Superintendent any identified areas of concern or recommendations. Any changes in grade level organization of a building shall be reported to all parents of students in that building.
