The USD 114 Reopening Plan provides guidance and expectations for leadership to implement plans based on the flexible framework to address challenges that may develop throughout the 2020-2021 school year.

***Remote Learning** - This option is available in the Traditional Model and the Hybrid Model to families who choose to enroll in USD 114 and prefer to receive online instruction off-site and have internet available. We will follow KSDE standards, which require self-documentation of mandated learning time, daily contact with a teacher, and responsibility for class assignments. Students are required to stay in this model for the semester. Remote students may not participate in USD 114 sports and extra-curricular activities.
