### INTRODUCTION

In an effort to accomplish the mission of **Cato Elementary School**, the school is committed to involving teachers, parents, community members and students.

PTA meetings are held throughout the year. The meetings' main focus is to enable the parents to be informed about ways they can be involved with the school, so that their child will be successful and productive.

## **PLANNED ACTIVITIES/MEETINGS (5.01.1.5)**

Each school year the Leadership Team Committee of **Cato Elementary School** will schedule the following activities in compliance with ACTS 397, 603, and 307:
