Dear Parents and Guardians,

Reopening Schools

Last week, I shared with you our plan to reopen schools and the changes to the school calendar. Links to these documents are provided again for your convenience. You will receive an invite to the follow up survey. At this time we are asking two questions, will your child(ren) be returning for in school learning or will you be opting to start the year with distance learning. If you will opt for distance learning, we have created a form for you to use. The form will be available with the same link used for the Reopening Plan. If your child(ren) will return to school, the survey asks if they will take the bus. We ask that you complete the survey and Opt for Distance Learning form by next Friday, August 7 for our planning purposes. Parents can change their mind. If this occurs during the summer, we ask that you let us know ASAP. Once school starts, we ask for 5 school days' notice to make a change.

Students who opt for distance learning will remain enrolled in the Lebanon Public Schools. They may participate in extracurricular activities and sports, but will have to provide their own transportation to practices, meetings and other related activities that occur at the schools. We will not be providing additional bus transportation for this.
