

Valley Board of Education Hall of Fame

Procedure for Selection of Committee members:

- 1) The committee shall submit up to 5 candidates worthy to be inducted into the BOE Hall of Fame.
- 2) The Valley BOE shall vote on the number to be inducted each year. Then from the list generated by the committee, the BOE shall vote up to 3 but a max of 5 members to be inducted that school year.
- 3) The nominating committee shall consist of Chair and Vice Chair of the current BOE, Superintendent, one Classified and Non-Classified employee. Volunteers shall submit their name to the Secretary/Treasurer of the board or Superintendents assistant. The President of the Board will select the 2 employees from the list submitted each year.
- 4) Superintendent shall be the secretary of the committee and take notes.

Nominating Criteria:

- 1) Nominee needs to have been an employee or alumni of the Valley School District. (Board members and coaches may also be nominated)
- 2) Nominee should have made significant contributions to the betterment of Valley Local School District.
- 3) Nominee must be no longer employed by school but can be in memory of that employee (deceased)
- 4) Length of service and contributions should be noted.

Process of Nomination:

- 1.) Any Valley community member or staff can nominate an individual.
- 2.) Nomination must be received by January 15th of the current school year.
- 3.) Nominating form will be available on our website. Form must be submitted to lindsey.turner@valleyls.org.

Recognition:

All honorees shall be given a plaque at a board meeting to be determined in the future by the BOE. In the event that the honoree is deceased then the family will be invited to accept the plaque in their honor.

Addition information:

The board has the right to remove any member convicted of a felony or behavior that the current BOE deems unworthy of being in the Hall of Fame.
