



Positive COVID Case Response

- Staff or students who become **infected** with COVID-19 (whether through the community or within the school) must be isolated at home for 14 days. Students considered to have come in close contact must be quarantined for 14 days.
- Elevated cases within a group or classroom may require extensive quarantine, including the dismissal of classes, buildings, or the entire school.
- In the event of an outbreak, which will be considered 3 cases within any group or more, all group members will be quarantined for 14 days.
- In the event of multiple outbreaks or affected groups, an entire school building may be closed.
- Re-opening of classes or buildings will not take place until after a 14-day quarantine to help prevent the spread of COVID-19.
- Staff and parents will be notified if there is a confirmed case of COVID-19 while protecting the privacy of the infected individual.
- During the event of a class or building closure, employees will be asked to tele-work, where appropriate, to continue to provide a vigorous, high quality education to students.
- During the event of a class or building closure, students will have access to distance learning.
