Should my child(ren) report to school?

Quarantine for at least 10 days from the first date of symptoms AND until fever free for 72 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications AND until symptoms have subsided.

Were they within 6 feet of positive person for 15 minutes or more, without a mask?

Follow MSDH recommendations on getting tested. If symptoms subside, and a test is not recommended by your physician, they may return after being symptom free for 72 hours.

Report to school.

Follow MSDH recommendations to be tested; quarantine at least 14 days from last date of exposure. If symptoms develop, quarantine at least 14 days from the onset of symptoms AND until fever free for 72 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication.

Report to school. Monitor for signs and symptoms up to 14 days. If symptoms develop, quarantine at least 14 days from the onset of symptoms AND until fever free for 72 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication.

COVID-19 Symptoms:

- Loss of taste or smell
- Cough
- Fever or chills
- Headache
- Fatigue
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Muscle or body aches
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
