2008 - NJ High School Redesign Steering Committee finalized a report with a new vision

2009 - New course requirements for graduation but standards do NOT align to college entrance requirements

2010 - NJ adopts the Common Core State Standards

2012 - College and Career Ready Task Force reviews and confirms NJ standards as appropriate for college and career readiness

2015 - First PARCC assessment given to NJ students

Keep in mind ...

First year of PARCC - Pattern history can NOT be developed

In 8th grade math, some students took the grade level PARCC assessment while other students took the Algebra 1 test.

Each student has a dramatic effect on Oaklyn scores.

Oaklyn PARCC students = 229 ... 2 students = almost 1%

Ex: 5th grade = 23 students ... 1 student = 4.3%

Students in the following states took PARCC assessments in the 2014-15 school year: Arkansas, Colorado, District of Columbia, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Mississippi, New Jersey, New Mexico, Ohio, and Rhode Island.
