Acceptable Electronic –Technology User Agreement

Internet access is available to authorized students through the Bennett County School District. The Internet is a vast archive full of information, not all of which is related to school. Availability of some materials on the Internet does not indicate endorsement by the Bennett County School District. In order to provide access to our students, they must carefully read and sign the following technology user agreement. **A parent or guardian must also read and sign the agreement on the back.**

In compliance with School Board policy (NEPN Code: JC) and procedures on student's rights and responsibilities, the following are to be followed:

- I will take good care of my Electronic Device.
- I will never leave my Electronic Device unattended.
- I will never loan out or let other individuals use my Electronic Device.
- I will keep food and beverages away from my Electronic Device.
- I will not disassemble any part of my Electronic Device or attempt any repairs.
- I will use my Electronic Device in ways that are educational, appropriate, and follow the Districts policies and procedures.
- I understand that my Electronic Device is subject to inspection at any time without notice and remains the property of the School District.
- I will ensure that care is taken with all hardware, software, and shared resources (printers, scanners) and the use of the School Network.
- I understand that I will keep my personal information and passwords private.
- I understand that inappropriate material is not allowed and will be subject to School disciplinary action.
- I will abide by all copyright and license agreements, including obtaining the approval for the use of another person's intellectual property.
- I will keep all settings on my Electronic Device that have been set by the teacher and/or technology coordinator.
- I will abide by all local, state, and federal rules and regulations.

Electronic Device Damage Agreement

Each student will be responsible for the device that is assigned to him or her. In the event that the device is broken, lost, or missing, the student and parent/guardian will be responsible for any costs incurred due to damage of equipment as determined by the school district.

The district will diagnose the damage, purchase replacement parts from the most reliable/cost efficient supplier and repairs will be made by the school personnel if capable of doing so. The repair will be made and an invoice will be submitted to the parent/guardian.

If the district personnel cannot repair the device, an estimate from a repair company will be requested. If the estimate is more than ½ of the replacement value of the equipment, it will then be surplus and the parent/guardian will be charged at the replacement cost.

Estimated Costs (May be Higher)

Chromebooks:

- Screens: \$40.00 to \$60.00 (depending on the model)
- Replacement Cost: \$275.00 to \$325.00 (depending on the model)

Macbooks:

- District Personnel will obtain and estimate repair costs from Computer Village. If the estimates exceed the cost of the original price, the cost will be the replacement of \$950.00

Ipad:

- Replacement Cost: \$500.00

Student: I have read and will abide by the District's Electronic Device policies and procedures. I further understand that any violation of these policies and procedures is unacceptable and may constitute a criminal offense. Should I commit any violation, my access privileges may be revoked and school disciplinary action and/or appropriate legal actions may be taken. First offense: loss of electronic device privileges for one day to a week. Second offense: loss of electronic device privileges for 2 weeks to a month. Third offense: loss of electronic devices privileges.

Parent/Guardian: I have read and agree to assist my child in understanding and abiding by the District's Acceptable Technology User Agreement. I understand that access to the District's equipment and its entire system of electronic communications is designed for educational purposes. I also understand that some materials on the Internet may be controversial and objectionable and that, while every attempt will be made to block inappropriate sites, it is impossible for the District to guarantee all inappropriate sites with controversial and objectionable materials will be blocked. I understand that the improper or inappropriate use of technology equipment and the District's system by my student may result in loss of privileges and may result in disciplinary action.
