

Early Childhood Screening



A team from the Lennox School District will conduct a screening for children 3 to 5 years of age. This is free and available to all children in the Lennox School District.

Screening at Lennox Ebenezer Presbyterian Church, August 26, 2020 (Please call by August 21st). Please note the new information regarding the screening procedures:

- ❖ Only 1 parent and child will enter through East door and exit through recommended door.
- ❖ Recommending parents stay in their cars/outside during the evaluation and/or we will work to allow for social distancing in the multi-purpose room depending on weather.
- ❖ Masks required by staff and parent; optional per child.
- ❖ Arrive only 5 minutes early.

Children will be screened in the following areas:

- Fine and Gross Motor Skills
- Pre-Readiness Skills
- Speech and Language Skills
- Self-Help and Social Checklist
- Hearing

***If your child is sick, please stay home, contact the school, and we will work to reschedule at a later date.

We highly recommend parent attendance to allow the option to evaluate your child; if necessary. Evaluations may be completed immediately; or, if needed can reschedule
