

Lunch Services

RCS students will have the following options for purchasing lunch beginning on the first day of school - Monday, August 17, 2020. Dining Hall staff will pre-package salads, as well as all food from Golden Corral and Papa John's Pizza.

- Golden Corral - Chicken tenders, macaroni & cheese, green beans, and a roll.
 - Tuesday and Thursday
- Papa John's Pizza - Pepperoni or Cheese pizza slices
 - Monday and Friday
- Please go to www.myschoolaccount.com between August 10 and 13 for those students who want to pre-order chicken tenders and pizza for Monday and Tuesday or Thursday and Friday, according to their schedule.
- Salad - Lettuce, tomatoes, cheese, bacon bits, meat (ham or turkey), salad dressing, croutons, crackers.
 - Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday
 - The salad will be made up of lettuce and cherry tomatoes. Cheese, bacon bits, meat and salad dressing will be inside the salad container in individual plastic cups with a lid.
- Each morning an email with an invitation to "Fill out form" will be sent to students. Those who wish to purchase a salad for that day will do so between 8 and 9 a.m. They will select the items that they want on their salads as well as if they would like to purchase a water, berry propel or chocolate milk.
- Students may also purchase individual items such as drinks, chips, crackers, cookies, etc. Please understand that these items will be limited. No frozen food items will be available.
- Lunches will be delivered and served in the students' classrooms.
- Students will still have the option of bringing their lunch from home. In our efforts to keep students and staff safe by reducing personal contact, we ask that you limit items that need to be warmed in the microwave.
- At this time, high school students (juniors and seniors) will not be allowed to leave campus for lunch. We will revisit this as the school year progresses.
- Due to our current situation and COVID protocols that must be followed please make sure your student has his or her lunch before leaving home each morning, unless he/she is purchasing lunch at school.
- Lunches may be dropped off only during the following times:
 - Middle school -- 10:45 to 11 a.m.
 - High school -- 12 to 12:15 p.m.
- **Please refer to the following protocol for dropping off lunches:**
 - Parent comes to the front door and buzzes Mrs. Graham -- masks must be worn at all times.
 - Mrs. Graham allows entry inside glass doors only.
 - Parent places lunch on table -- bag must be labeled with student's first and last name and grade level.
 - Parent leaves and Mrs. Graham calls student to retrieve lunch.
