COVID 19 INFORMATIONAL PARENT MEETING



1. What will the school day be like for my child/ren?

Upon arrival children will have their temperature taken before exiting the car. Students will enter the classroom and use the hand sanitizer, then have a seat at their desk. Students may talk to one another while waiting for all students to arrive, and will continue wearing masks during instruction. They may take their masks off during silent work at their desks, but must put them back on to ask a question or talk. Whenever students leave the classroom they must wear a mask, and will use the hand sanitizer when returning into the classroom.

*Water fountains will not be in use. Please make sure that students have a water bottle (Labeled with names) for the classroom.





2. Will there be a hot lunch program?

Yes, NLRCA will have hot lunches available daily.



3. Will the school be sanitized daily?

Yes, NLRCA has purchased a hand held machine that will be used to disinfect the classrooms and offices.



4. How will NLRCA implement Social Distancing?

NLRCA has placed tape on the hallway floor at 6ft. intervals to ensure that students apply the six foot rule. Also, the excess furniture has been removed from classrooms where needed to ensure that we can place desks at appropriate safe distances.

Bathrooms have been equipped with automatic soap and paper towel dispensers as well as plexiglass partitions between the sinks.





5. What time is the school open and what time is dismissal?

Morning Care will begin at 6:30am and will last until 7:15am. At 7:15am, all students entering the school will go directly to their respective classrooms.

Dismissal will be at 3:15pm. Students will remain in their classroom until their parent/ guardian arrives or After School Care begins. After School Care will begin at 4:00pm and will last until 6:00pm.

**Please reply to Dismissal questionnaire to ensure a smooth/ efficient dismissal.



6. How will students eat in the classroom or cafeteria?

Students will eat in the cafeteria, where seating will be arranged for optimal social distancing. Students will be served the hot lunches at their seat instead of in line. They may take their masks off after all hot lunches have been served to eat. The cafeteria will be sanitized after each group.

On PE Days, students will eat in the classroom.



7. What if a child is sick upon arrival?

If a child's temperature is over 100 degrees- the child may not stay at school.





8. What will happen if NLRCA closes during the school year?

NLRCA is prepared to remote learn until the crisis passes and and the school re-opens.



9. Will temperatures be taken daily?

Yes, temperatures will be taken daily upon arrival before entering the school building.



10. If my child has allergies may he/she still come to school?

Yes, but we do ask that they take medication.





11. Will Mass be offered to the children this year?

Fr. Ruben is working on a schedule for School Masses.



12. Can NLRCA students attend REMOTE LEARNING during this school year?

Yes, students may choose to remote learn during the school year, but must follow the classroom schedule and uniform dress code.



13. What happens if a student/ family is diagnosed with Covid 19.

**Immediately notify the school office.

The office and staff will notify the Diocese, CDC, and families. Each case will be handled individually upon the instructions of both the Diocese and the CDC regarding quarantining/ or testing the class or the entire school. During quarantine, classes will remote learn and the school will be sanitized. Quarantine will last for 14 days, unless instructed otherwise.

NLRCA has a quarantine room in place with trained staff in the event that a student becomes ill with fever at school.





14. Out of State Vacations

Please plan accordingly- All students who go out of the state of Arkansas must quarantine for 14 days before entering the school building. This applies to prior to the first day of school as well as during the school year and Thanksgiving/ Christmas Breaks. Students may remote learn until quarantine has lifted.



15. COVID 19 WAIVER

The Covid 19 Waiver **must be signed** before the child/ren begin the school year.

**This Waiver is mandated by the Catholic Diocese, and NLRCA is not allowed to teach your child until it is signed.

Waivers will be available during registration on August 11 from 9:00 am - Noon. Waivers are also available on the school's website: nlrca.org (Under News).

16. Are Parents Allowed to Enter the School Building

At this time, we ask that parents do not enter the school building to ensure the safety of our students and staff.

Parents may call the school office to schedule virtual meetings with Mrs. Troutman and/or Teachers.

To Check a Child Out: Parents need to call the school office on arrival and a staff member will meet you out front.



17. Arrival

Students in Pre-K will use the Pre-K drop-off circle.
Families with students in Kindergarten or First Grade will use the private drive.
All other families will use the Front Door drop-off circle.

Students arriving after 8:00am need to call the office and will be met by staff to take temperature before drop-off.



18. Will there be sports this year.

As of right now, Triple A Sports and Church League Cross Country/ Track are set. We are working on making Church League Volleyball available.





19. Special Classes

Computer Class and the Science Lab will be put on hold until the end of the Covid 19 crisis.

Art, Music, and Spanish will be offered in the classrooms with a rotating teacher.

PE will be offered in the gym using safe distance and sanitization guidelines.



19. Special Events

As of right now, all special events and large gatherings are postponed until the Covid 19 crisis is over.
