USD 218 Re-Opening Mission

Elkhart Public School District commits to re-opening efforts that focus on providing an educational environment that is: physically and emotionally safe for students and staff, that prioritizes nurturing and meaningful connections among the school community, and creates high-quality learning opportunities for students.

On-Site

Students and staff attend on-site with enhanced and mandatory health and safety protocols put in place. This will be implemented when there are low levels of community health restrictions.

****Parent Choice Remote Learning is available as an option for USD 218 families. This is the option for families who do not wish to have their child(ren) attend on-site.*

Hybrid

Students spend part of their time in the classroom and part of their time learning remotely. Students may be assigned to stable groups and asked to attend on-site in a controlled environment while also doing remote learning. This phase may be implemented when there are moderate to high levels of community restrictions.

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Remote

Students receive their learning remotely by USD 218 teachers using Google Classroom and Zoom. This is the most restrictive situation, implemented at a single school, multiple schools, or entire district when there are high levels of community restrictions. 360 minutes of instruction time logged daily and turned in weekly.
