

## Activity Meeting Questions:

1. Where will we put our stuff during the day to keep it safe?
  - a. Right now, the Aux Gym will be utilized to keep your things. We will staff it in the morning to get everything put in there. Whether it will be staffed all day or locked once school starts has yet to be determined.
2. Will Region 1 be streaming their home games if they don't already?
  - a. The majority of the schools will be streaming their games. There are only a couple who didn't already have streaming capabilities and they are working with vendors right now to set that up. All of our games, as usual, will be streamed.
3. Will there be practices on Fridays?
  - a. That is a determination that will be made by the coaches. At this time, I do not believe the elementary or JH volleyball coaches are planning on practicing on Fridays. This is ALWAYS subject to change depending on the week or situation.
4. Will transportation be provided to/from games?
  - a. Yes. The board recently approved busing the elementary teams to games. If there is a game on Friday, we are still working on how transportation will look for that, especially at the younger levels, and we will get that information out next week.
5. Will the home side of the football field be open (including the track) during games?
  - a. The track behind the players' box will remain roped off to provide a buffer between the players and fans. The track on the ends and outside the players' box will be open to the public. We have added more road base to raise the walking path to the track to help keep everyone dry on their way to the field.
6. There was a question about quarantining. I will capture the essence of the question below and try to provide clarity.
  - a. If a participant tests positive for COVID-19, the school would be notified, and the team would enter quarantine. The quarantine is 14 days from the last exposure to the positive test.
  - b. If, during the quarantine, a close contact would start to show symptoms, and a test comes back positive, their quarantine/isolation would start over.
  - c. If your child is considered a close contact, you, as a parent/guardian would NOT need to worry about quarantining unless your child were to test positive or show symptoms.
