Attendance awards will be postponed for the 2020-2021 school year



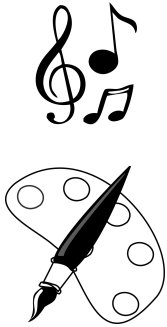
Volunteer program will be suspended for the 2020-2021 school year
