WSCUHSD Charge Policy for Students

Assembly Bill 130 passed on July 9, 2021 to provides additional Proposition 98 funding to address the state meal reimbursement in the 2021–22 School Year (SY) for Seamless Summer Option (SSO) served meals and will convert to State Universal Meal Program for the 2022-2023 SY.

California Universal Feeding models provides all students the option to be offered one free reimbursable breakfast and one free reimbursable lunch during the school year regardless of qualification for free or reduced-price eligibility based on household income. There will not be a need to charge for meals due to the inability to pay. Students will be allowed to purchase additional meals and "a la carte" snacks and beverages but will not be allowed to charge for these additional items. A la carte items include smart snacks, beverages, frozen treats, and second meals. Second meals are prohibited from being charged but can be purchased for the regular meal price; \$2.00 for breakfast and \$3.50 for lunch.

Alternative meals will not be offered.

Adults will be allowed to charge for meals at \$2.75 for breakfast and \$4.25 for lunch. Those with balances will be notified monthly via email or paper notices. Balances will remain on employee food accounts until paid in full. Staff will be discouraged not to have balances owed greater than \$60.

All families are encouraged to complete the current school year meal application annually to assist with additional student services, school site supplemental funding, and P-EBT benefits. Applications are available prior to registration and throughout the school year.

Families are encouraged to prepay for meals online through an electronic prepayment system with www.myschoolbucks.com or in the school cafeteria with cash or check.
