## Senior Paint the Parking Space



**Guideline and Agreement Form** 2023-2024

#### **Overview:**

This year senior drivers will have the opportunity to rent and paint/personalize a parking space on campus. The parking spaces will be rented at a cost of \$35. This will include the cost of your 2022-2023 parking permit. Other money collected will be deposited and used for the senior class as well as offset the cost of materials/labor to recover. Checks are payable to South Central Schools. Only seniors will be given the opportunity to rent a parking space. A map of parking spaces will be available and can be selected on a first come, first serve basis, beginning on August 9th at 7:30 AM, in the high school office. All parking forms must be completed in order to select a parking space. Parking spaces will be available for purchase until August 26th. A parking space design request is included in this document. The design of your parking space will need to be approved by an S.C.H.S. administrator, or designee representatives, and all paint must be verified by an administrator or designated representatives **before** painting can begin. There are many approved painting days so far: 8/11 (11 a.m.-2 p.m.), 8/13 (10 a.m.-2 p.m.), 8/15 (9 a.m.-12 p.m.), 8/15 (5 p.m.- 8 p.m.), 8/17 (5 p.m.-8 p.m.), 8/18 (10 a.m.-1 p.m.) and 8/20 (9 p.m.-12 p.m.). Additional days may be added as time progresses, see the high school website for more details.

#### **Guidelines (Sketch):**

Think of your space as a t-shirt you would wear to school. Your parking spot must meet dress code approval. Keep it classy! Any design associated with gangs, drugs, alcohol, violence, obscene/suggestive slogans, and/or symbols will not be permitted. Designs such as handicap symbols, or other symbols that may cause confusion and/or promote illegal activities will not be allowed. You may include your name, jersey number, an instrument you play, your hobby, famous quotes or slogans, and anything unique to you so that it meets with

administrative approval.

WATER BASED EXTERIOR LATEX paint is the only type of paint that can be used. Students will also need to leave a four-inch unpainted border between the yellow parking space lines and the paint in their parking spot. You will be required to use blue painter's tape to ensure this border is accomplished. You may purchase water-based latex paint at retail stores like Sherwin Williams, Lowes, and Home Depot, Ace Hardware. All paint will be the responsibility of the student. At this time, the school will recover the spots at the end of the school year. However, South Central Local School reserves the right to require all senior students to recover their parking spaces based on the projected summer budget and projects.

## **Unapproved Paints:**



•No oil-based paints •No reflective paint •No spray paint •No fluorescent paint

\*\* Non-water-based exterior latex significantly increases the cost and time commitment required to recover. Students who circumvent this requirement could be assessed financial penalties and/or disciplinary actions.




### **Painting Party:**
