

Woods School Outbreak Response Matrix

The health department will work with the individual family. The school will investigate, communicate and contact trace anytime a student is diagnosed or reports being in contact with someone who is positive.

Low Below 5% positive cases	1 student or staff member diagnosed	Close the classroom or cohort for 1 day to clean and sanitize.
	2-4 students or staff diagnosed	Close the classroom or cohort for 3 days to clean and sanitize. Teachers provide virtual instruction.
	5+ students or staff diagnosed	Close the classroom, cohort or school for 5 days to clean and sanitize. Teachers will provide virtual instruction.
Moderate 5-10% positive cases	1 student or staff member diagnosed	Close the classroom or cohort for 1 day to clean and sanitize.
	2-4 students or staff diagnosed	Close the classroom or cohort for 3 days to clean and sanitize. Teachers provide virtual instruction.
	5+ students or staff diagnosed	Close the classroom, cohort or school for 5 days to clean and sanitize. Teachers will provide virtual instruction.
Substantial Above 10% positive cases	1 student or staff member diagnosed	Close the classroom or cohort for 3 days to clean and sanitize. Teachers provide virtual instruction.
	2-4 students or staff diagnosed	Close the classroom, cohort or school for 5 days to clean and sanitize. Teachers will provide virtual instruction.
	5+ students or staff diagnosed	Close the classroom, cohort or school for 10 days. Monitor for any additional cases during this time (parent reporting) in order to determine return to school or continued closure. Teachers provide virtual instruction.
