**Information about scheduling your student(s):**

- As a starting point, students were divided alphabetically for A/B days and AM/PM sessions. With some exceptions, students with last names starting with letters A-L will attend A days (T/TH) and students with last names starting with letters M-Z will attend B days (W/F) at the junior high and high school. With some exceptions, students with last names starting with letters A-L will attend in the morning at Lincoln Trail, and students with last names starting with A-M will attend AM at Middletown Prairie. Remaining elementary students (M-Z at LT and N-Z at MPE) will attend in the afternoon.

- To balance classes and sections, there are some students that were not assigned by last name. **Those families that were not assigned by last name will be notified by building staff no later than Wednesday afternoon, August 5, 2020 of their placement.**
