## Our Role as a Teacher...

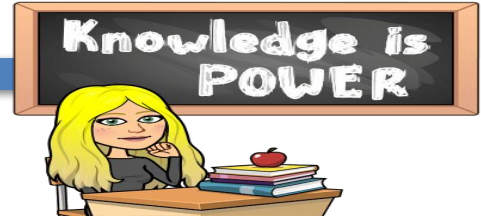
- Promote student success in an online learning environment

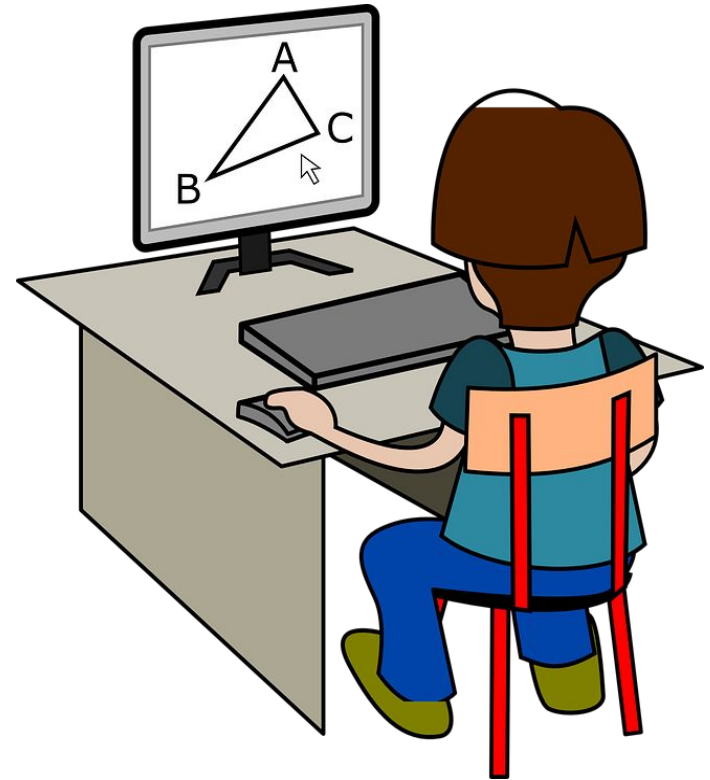
- Zoom
