### THREE YEAR PHYSICAL CLEARANCE EXTENSION

The MSHSL Board of Directors Executive Committee approved the extension of the expiration date of the Three-Year Physical Clearance.

\*A student with a three-year clearance that expires at any time from March 12, 2020 through the conclusion of the 2020-2021 school year will have the clearance extended through the completion of the 2020-2021 school year.

\*Each student must still complete the annual health history questionnaire.

\*Any student who had not previously participated and who does not have medical clearance to participate will be required to have a physical and be cleared to participate.

**All incoming 7th graders and new athletes need to pick up a MSHSL physical form to take to the appointment.**

If you do not know these, please call the Community Ed Office at 386-6028 to get that information. **DO NOT** create a new account. Online registration is for credit card or debit card payments only. **\*You are required to fill out the MSHSL forms to be eligible for sports. There are four forms: Health Questionnaire, Emergency Card, Eligibility, and Waiver. These forms need to be filled out before athletes are allowed to practice.**

### ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY

The student-athlete comes first! Every other week of the trimester, a report will be generated of all athletes' grades. If a student has an F in any course, the student will be given a slip. This student will bring the slip to their teacher and must be signed at the end of the week with either of the following to be **ELIGIBLE**:

- student is now passing
- student is making adequate progress towards passing if the student does not turn the slip in, does not get their course grade up, or is not considered as making adequate progress, the student will be considered **INELIGIBLE**.
  - 1st offense in a season will sit out 1 competition or game
  - 2nd offense in a season will sit out 2 competitions or games
  - 3rd offense in a season will sit out 3 competitions or games

\*\*The students will be allowed to practice during the first 3 offenses but will not be allowed to travel or playing in games either home or away. 4th offense, the student will not be allowed to practice, travel or compete until the student is passing the course.

### ATTENDANCE

\* Absent on the day of practice: If a student is excused from school with permission, then they shall be allowed to practice that day. If a student has an unexcused absence or was absent due to illness for any class periods, then they shall not be allowed to practice or travel that day. (This includes students who choose to leave for "open lunch" without permission.)

\* Absent the day of a game: On the day of competition or games, the students must be in school for the whole day unless they have a doctor's appointment (a doctor's note may be required).

\* Suspension from School: A student suspended from school may not participate or practice in a league activity during the time of suspension.



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
