

TPS CLASS SUPPLY LISTS 2020-2021

Supply lists this year have been harder to create due to the different learning formats and the financial strain we know some families are experiencing. The following lists include what is needed no matter where your child is doing their work, but none of this has to be new. If you already have some of these supplies, use them! If your child is starting at home but ends up in the building later, they will need to bring supplies they have been using with them (all students will have personal supplies instead of community supplies). **Any supplies with * means they only need it when they are in the building.** If your family would like to buy an extra set of supplies for a family who needs our support, we will happily accept donations. You can drop these by the school front door Monday-Friday 8:30a-4p.

KINDERGARTEN

- 1 pencil box no larger than 6x9, but large enough to hold markers, crayons, glue stick, pencil, scissors *
- 4 jump Elmer's Glue Sticks
- 1 pack of Crayola 24 count crayons
- 1 pack of Crayola Ultra Clean Washable Markers, Classic Color – 8 count
- 1 pack multi-colored construction paper
- 1 pack white multi-purpose printer paper
- 1 box pencils for home learning (F2F not needed; we have plenty!)
- 1 scissors for home learning (F2F not needed; we have plenty!)
- 1 box of tissues*
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes (if available)*
- 2 rolls of paper towel *
- 1 box of quart size baggies (last names starting with A-M only) *
- 1 box of gallon size baggies (last names starting with N-Z only) *

- 2 different sized paint brushes
- Scrap paper/old magazines OR multi-pack of construction paper
- 1 water bottle *
