



## SEPT 9<sup>th</sup> RETURN TO SCHOOL: FAQ

- **When will virtual and hybrid students begin?**
  - All students will begin school on September 9, 2020.
- **What transition services will be in place to support students changing school buildings?**
  - PreK , Kindergarten, and 6<sup>th</sup> grade will schedule appointments to allow these students a transition time to get to know the teacher and learn the building.
- **Will face coverings be required?**
  - All individuals who enter a CCSD building or bus will be required to use a face covering.
- **When will high school students receive a schedule?**
  - Counselors and Administrators are currently registering students. Information will be available in Power School prior to the online orientation.
- **When will the online/virtual orientation/open house be scheduled?**
  - Orientation is the week of August 31- September 4. A system message will be sent indicating which grade level/content level is scheduled for each day. The orientation will be available in a live session and will be recorded for viewing at a time convenient for families.
- **When is the orientation for the full time Virtual Academy Model?**
  - September 1, 2020 will be the orientation. The assigned facilitator will be in contact with the student/family prior to September 1 with additional log-in information.
- **Will my child be allowed to take the course offerings in Edgenuity?**
  - Students can enroll in the available Edgenuity course offerings that align with the child's specific graduation plan and pathway completion plan.
- **Will my child still receive specialized services in the hybrid and/or virtual model?**
  - Yes. All services that a child meets eligibility requirements will be provided. Please work directly with the student's case manager and Assistant Principal for specific questions or concerns.

- **Will the full time Virtual Academy model be available after semester one?**
  - Yes. Students will have the opportunity after the Thanksgiving Break to register for continued enrollment in the full time Virtual Academy model for semester two.
  
- **Will dual enrollment be available for students?**
  - Yes. Those students who meet the requirements for dual enrollment will have the option to register for those courses.
  
- **Will students have access to wrap-around services like counselors or social workers?**
  - Yes. All services remain available for children and families. The collaboration with the Columbus Wellness Center and with New Horizons.
  
- **How will attendance be monitored?**
  - Students in the hybrid model will be expected to attend in person class on their assigned day(s). The distance learning tasks are expected to be completed in the timeline assigned by the teacher and prior to the next in person scheduled time. For students enrolled in the full time Virtual Academy, the modules are self- paced. All required modules are expected for completion and mastery prior to the end of the semester in order to earn credit.
  
- **Will school nutrition be available to my child?**
  - Yes. Students who are enrolled in the full time Virtual Academy model will have the opportunity to pick up a five days of meals. Students attending school on the Hybrid model will have the opportunity to pick up meals for the days that they are not scheduled for in person instruction.
  
- **If my child needs additional academic assistance, what should I do?**
  - For students enrolled in the full time Virtual Academy model, the child should work directly with the assigned CCSD facilitator that will be assigned to them. For students attending school on the hybrid model, the scheduled content/grade level teacher will be available for support. Email is the best method to reach teachers.
  
- **What happens if my child gets sick or feels ill?**
  - In the event that your child is not feeling well, please make sure that they do not attend school on their assigned day. Contact the homeroom teacher via email. Parents: It is imperative that you do temperature checks and health checks prior to sending your child to school.
  
- **What precautions will be in place in the buildings?**
  - Health checks including temperature checks will be in place at each building. In the event that a student has a fever, the student's parents will be immediately contacted for pick up. The child will be sent to the Care Connect School Clinic. If an individual reports a positive COVID-19 case to the school, parents will be contacted informing them of the positive diagnosis. Deep cleaning and sanitization protocols will be enacted as well.
