2020-2021 Learning Options

Hillsboro USD 410 realizes that each family's health situations are unique. For the entirety of the 2020-2021 school year, parents may choose between one of three options: In-Person Learning, Remote Learning or TEEN Virtual School. Each option is described in detail below. Regardless of your choice, we want your children to love learning and be excited about life. You are not locked into your first choice.

Option 1 In-Person Learning

- Students are in attendance at their school.
- Classrooms will support a blended format. (Google classroom, Canvas etc.)
- Nontraditional spaces can be used for instruction.
- Transitions will be limited/staggered.
- Staff and students will wear face coverings. Social distance when possible.
- Health checks will be done upon entrance.
- Hands will be cleaned every hour.
- Students maintain regular enrollment status.
- Students who enroll in this option are eligible for activities.

Option 2 Remote Learning

- Students follow their school schedule online and it requires the same length of time spent on school learning activity as a traditional school day.
- Teachers meet with students daily utilizing web conferencing technology for each class.
- Instruction may occur remotely or on campus as appropriate.
- Daily visual/verbal connection with a teacher.
- Grading/assignments remain the same as in person.

- Students maintain regular enrollment status.
- Students who enroll in this option are eligible for in-person activities.

Option 3- TEEN Virtual

- 6th-12th grade students only
- Students will use Edgenuity curriculum.
- Class work can be completed outside of traditional school day.
- Students are not eligible for USD 410 activities.
