



# AGS Return to Learn Details

## Fall 2020

### School Day

- Breakfast at 7:30 a.m.
- Doors open at 7:45 a.m. for those not eating breakfast - ***TARDY BELL rings at 8:00 a.m.***
- Hours: Monday through Friday - **8:00 a.m. - 1:30 p.m.**

### Self-Certification

All families must self-certify their child through the Skyward app daily by 7:15 a.m. in order to attend school with no symptoms. The office will call parents/guardians of students that are not self-certified to certify them. For those without internet access for Skyward, an attendance sheet will be initialled daily by parent/guardian.

### Additional School Supplies for All Students

- A minimum of one reusable mask - washed daily

### Items that the School will Provide for Each Student

- One mask
- Reusable water bottle
- Lanyard - will remain at school

### Items to Discuss with your student(s) before the First Day of School

- Practice wearing a mask at home
- How to maintain social distancing
- Explain there is no congregating, “social gathering”, before or after school on school property
- Keeping hands to themselves and maintain personal space
- Personal items cannot be shared

### Arriving At School

Students will be required to arrive at school with their mask on. Bus riders will remain on their bus until 7:45 a.m. At that time, students will unload one bus at a time to enter the building and go straight to their classroom. Walkers will be dropped off at school beginning at 7:45 a.m.

**Students should plan to arrive no earlier than 7:45 a.m.** Please drop your student off at the door listed below according to their grade.

- **PreK/Kindergarten** - East side doors by PreK and Kindergarten classrooms
- **1st, 2nd, 3rd** - West side doors by sidewalk between playgrounds
- **4th, 5th** - North side doors by 4th and 5th grade wing
- **6th** - West side doors on junior high wing
- **7th** - South side doors on junior high wing
- **8th** - East side doors on junior high hallway

### **Pick-up or Drop-off Procedures During School Hours**

If Parents/Guardians need to pick up or drop off their student(s) during school hours, they will come to the circle drive by the grade school office. Parents/Guardians will remain in their car and call the grade school office at 217-543-2109. A staff member will walk the student(s) in or out.

### **Dismissal Procedures**

Bus riders will be dismissed one bus at a time when all buses arrive at approximately 1:30.

Walkers who have younger siblings will be dismissed after all buses have left the circle drive.

The remaining students will be dismissed by one classroom at a time. **Please remain in your car and pick your child up at the grade level doors that you dropped them off at.** For

parents/guardians who have multiple students, please pick up at the door of the youngest student.

Staff members will walk their students and help them find their parents' car when needed.

### **Playground**

The blacktop and grassy areas on the school property will be used for PE and recess/mask breaks, when weather permits. During these times, students will be able to remove their masks while outside as they maintain 6 feet social distancing.

### **Cafeteria**

**Breakfast** - Students who will be eating breakfast at school will need to be dropped off at the PreK/Kindergarten entrance. Students should exit their cars with their mask on and go directly to the cafeteria. Students will use the hand sanitizer outside the cafeteria door and will be directed to their seat. They will then remove their mask, place it in their book bag which will be right beside them on the bench. A staff member will serve them their breakfast. At 7:45 a.m., students can leave the cafeteria with their mask on and go to their classroom.

**Lunch** - Students will eat lunch in the cafeteria or gym by grade level. Students will arrive at the cafeteria/gym after washing their hands, seated by staff using social distancing, remove their mask & place it on their lanyard, and those who ordered lunch will be served by staff. Five minutes will be allotted in between grade levels to allow for cleaning tables.

### **Meals for Remote Learners**

We will be working out details to provide meals for remote learners. As soon as this is finalized we will communicate that with the families.

### **Mask Break/Recess**

Each class will be scheduled a time during the morning to go outside, weather permitting, for a ten-minute mask break and brief recess. No personal items brought to school for use during recess.

### **Classroom**

Students will be spaced out in classrooms to the best of our ability to maintain social distancing as much as possible. Students will be required to wear masks. There will be cleaning supplies and hand sanitizer in each classroom. All students will be assigned a homeroom classroom that they will remain in for their instruction, including junior high students. Junior High teachers and K-6 specials teachers (PE, art, music) will rotate to the classroom to instruct students. Special services, such as Title, Special Ed, Speech, Social Work, etc. may provide their services in a separate classroom.

### **Restrooms**

All restrooms will be limited to two students at a time. There will be a hook outside the restroom door for students to hang their lanyard indicating that the restroom is in use. Signs will be displayed in the restrooms for proper hand washing technique.

### **Hallways**

Hallways will have markings that are 6 feet apart for social distancing. Transition periods will be limited to small groups as needed.

### **JH Lockers**

Lockers will not be used at this time. Junior high students will be required to have a backpack with all of their school supplies for each class, lunch box (if bringing lunch), and their charged chromebook in its case (7th and 8th graders). When inclement weather arrives, students will place their coat on the back of their chair or in their backpack.

### **Visitors/Volunteers**

Until further notice, **visitors will not be allowed in the building.**

### **Treats**

No Birthday treats at this time.

### **JH Schedule (7th & 8th Grade)**

**All students will attend all classes at Arthur Grade School building.** Students will need to bring their book bag to their homeroom classroom, which is their 2nd hour class.
