2023-2024 SENIOR FINE ARTS SCHOLARSHIP GENERAL RULES AND GUIDELINES

Scholarships Available: Up to four \$500.00 scholarships per year including the Kelly Leatherman Scholarship, which is specifically designated for a music student (please see the back for further information). The other scholarships are not designated to specific programs (involvement in one or more programs will be considered).

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The student must be enrolled as a senior and graduate from the Northeastern Local School district while in a fine arts program (band, choir, drama, art) until the time of graduation. Students pursuing a post-secondary degree in a fine arts related field may be given preference for the scholarships. Sex, race, and religion are not conditions for eligibility of scholarships.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1. All scholarship applications must be on the official Tinora Fine Arts Boosters application form found at: <http://www.tinora.org/ram-music>. All information must be typed, except the student signature. Additional attachments must be typed. Incomplete applications or late submissions will not be considered.
2. Completed forms must be printed, signed, and submitted in a sealed envelope to the Tinora Fine Arts Boosters mailbox in the high school office to the attention of Amy Thomas, Scholarship Coordinator.
3. Completed applications must be submitted no later than Friday, January 5, 2024.

DISBURSEMENTS

All Tinora Fine Arts Boosters Scholarships are disbursed in January of the following year directly to the student. Before the disbursement, the student must provide a transcript of their first semester or quarter academic grades. Payment will be disbursed upon receipt of the transcript.
