Pilot Grove C-4 In Seat vs. Virtual Opportunity Learning 2020-2021



The 2020-21 school year will begin on Tuesday, August 25th, 2020 for all students in the Pilot Grove C-4 School District. In an effort to protect the safety, wellbeing and family situations of students during the pandemic, Pilot Grove C-4 School District students will be provided the following options for fall enrollment:

- In-Person Enrollment
 - Students attend school in seat with health precautions in place.
- Online/Virtual Enrollment
 - o 100% online/virtual enrollment created/delivered by district approved online vendors: Edmentum and A+ Learning System
- Homeschool
 - o Parents will need to contact the appropriate school office if this is your decision.

Detailed information on the in-person enrollment can be found in the 2020-21 District Re-Entry Plan on the District Website. The following information provided outlines the Pilot Grove C-4 Online/Virtual Enrollment option for 2020-21.

Parents who select the online/virtual enrollment option will need to submit virtual enrollment forms to the District office by 3pm on Friday, August 14th. Click for <u>Virtual Learning Registration</u>

This will provide the District an opportunity to arrange student and class schedules and enroll students who select an online option. Virtual/online enrollment forms are available on the District's website for families to complete and submit to the District. The form is located through the Explore button, then select the school building: Elementary or Secondary. Upon completion of the Virtual Enrollment form, a building level administrator or the counselor will contact parents regarding online/virtual school.

Parents/students who select an online/virtual option and enroll through the school district will be at no cost to the family/student. Enrollment and course fees, if enrolled through the district, will be assumed by the school district. Parents/students who enroll in virtual courses independently, outside of the district's enrollment process, will be responsible for all enrollment costs and course fees.

Students/parents must commit to a minimum of one full semester of virtual enrollment, beginning Tuesday, August 25th ad concluding Friday, December 18th at 3pm.

Students must complete the course in its entirety by the end of the first semester in order to receive credit for the class. Virtual instruction will occur in the student's home at the parent's direction. If a student does not complete or is not successful in a course, the student may not receive credit towards grade level completion or graduation. Student failure to compete coursework or lack of progress/success in online learning could result in the inability to enroll in virtual courses for future semesters.

Students who enroll in virtual courses are still enrolled students of the Pilot Grove C-4 School District and will be required to take state-required MAP/EOC assessments administered by the District.

Students who enroll in virtual courses and receive special education and/or related services (IEP services) must meet with the student's IEP team to determine special education and related services service delivery and placement options.

School-based meal/food-service will not be provided for students who enroll in a virtual option.

Students are responsible for securing their own technology and devices for virtual instruction.

Students who select virtual courses will not be allowed to participate in extracurricular activities until returned to in seat instruction.

Parents/students who choose to continue virtual enrollment for second semester must notify the District by Friday, December 11, 2020.

The District will send a form to students participating in 1st semester virtual instruction indicating the student's desire to continue or discontinue virtual instruction for 2nd semester.
