## School Transportation (Bus and Other Vehicles)

The Fessenden-Bowdon Board of Education has adopted policies (FCBB) to ensure the safety of all students. Riding the bus, or being transported by school vehicles is a privilege, and we need students to follow the rules established by the district to keep everyone safe. Please discuss the rules with your child(ren) and ensure they understand that **riding is a privilege, and they can lose the privilege of riding in school vehicles if they choose to not obey the rules.** 

#### **SEAT BUCKLES**

All school vehicles have seat buckles and students are REQUIRED to wear them, whether it is riding a regular bus route or to activities. SAFETY is our priority. For the safety of all students, if a child chooses to not wear, they will lose riding privileges as determined by the administration.

#### **BUS ROUTE INFORMATION**

We are still looking for another bus driver for this year. If you are interested in driving, please contact the school office.

The bus drivers will be calling you to let you know what time your child(ren) will be picked up and dropped off. If your child(ren) will not be riding the bus, please call your driver by 6:00AM to ensure they get the message before leaving on the route. The driver's cell numbers are listed on bus route sheet; you may also contact the Main Office from 8:00-4:00 at 547-3296, and they will relay the message to the driver. Many times after school, students may not ride for various reasons, therefore the route may vary slightly, depending upon who is riding. It is up to the driver's discretion to determine the most efficient way to get students home as quickly as possible after school.

#### DROPPING OFF AND PICKING UP CHILDREN

Our school day runs from 8:30-3:30, and teachers use every minute to make sure your child is learning what is required to be successful in school. Please drop students off no earlier than 8:00AM, and wait until 3:30PM to pick your children up at the end of the day. If you arrive early, we ask that you remain by the office until the bell rings to minimize distractions to the classrooms.
