<u>Demonstrating Competency/Proficiency in The Arts</u>

The district will manage the assessment process so that students seeking competency-based credit can demonstrate competency/proficiency in art skills.

A student may recover one (1) art credit if the student meets standard on another approved state alternative that meets the graduation requirement.

Additionally, a student may obtain one (1) art credit for passing a district created assessment that is aligned to state learning standards, such as a portfolio of student work. Students do not need to have attempted and failed a course before being eligible for this option.
