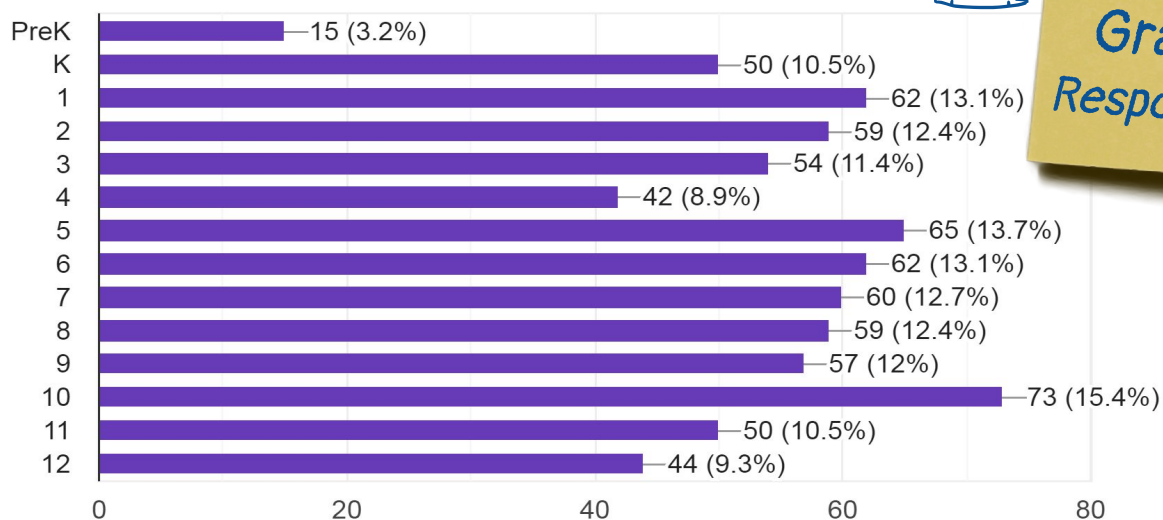

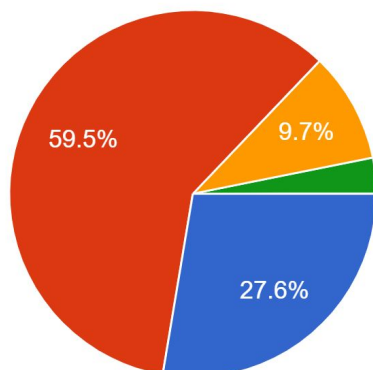

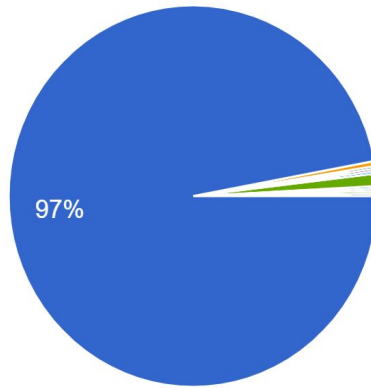

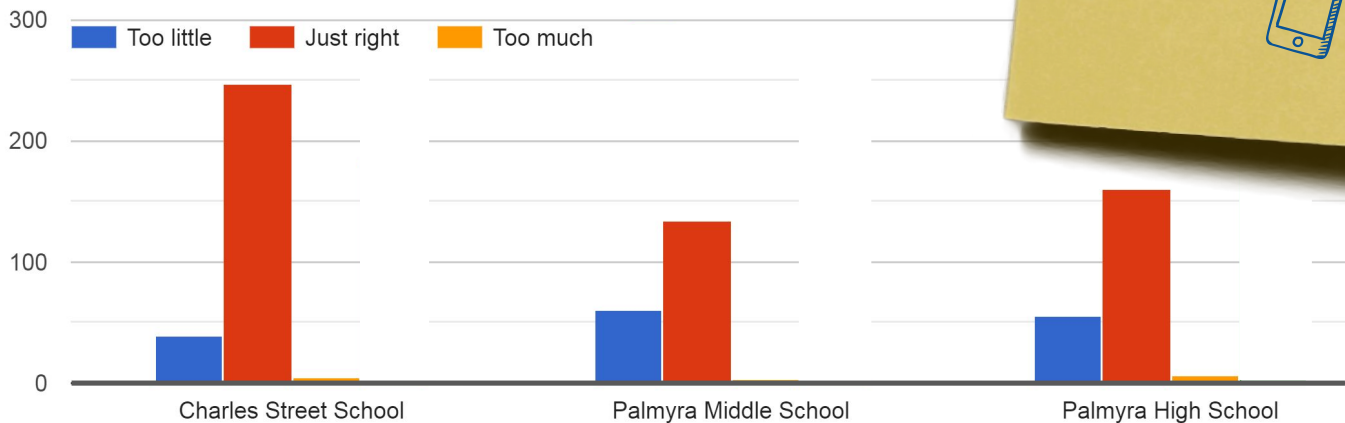

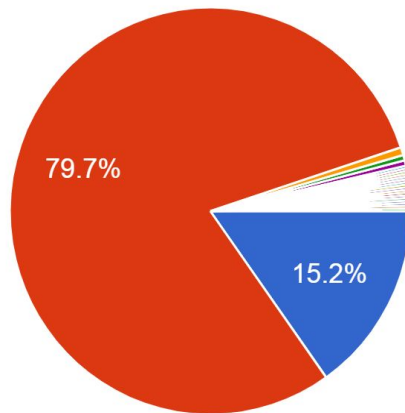

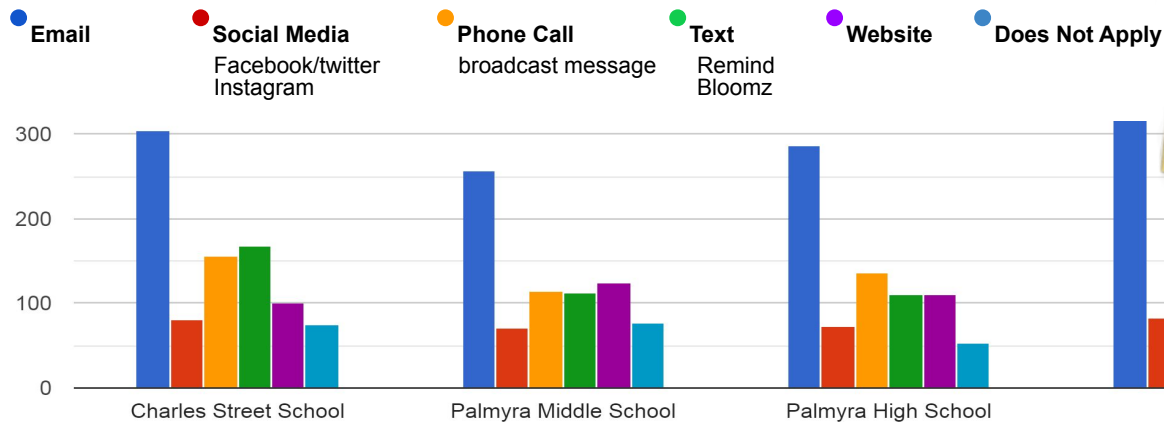

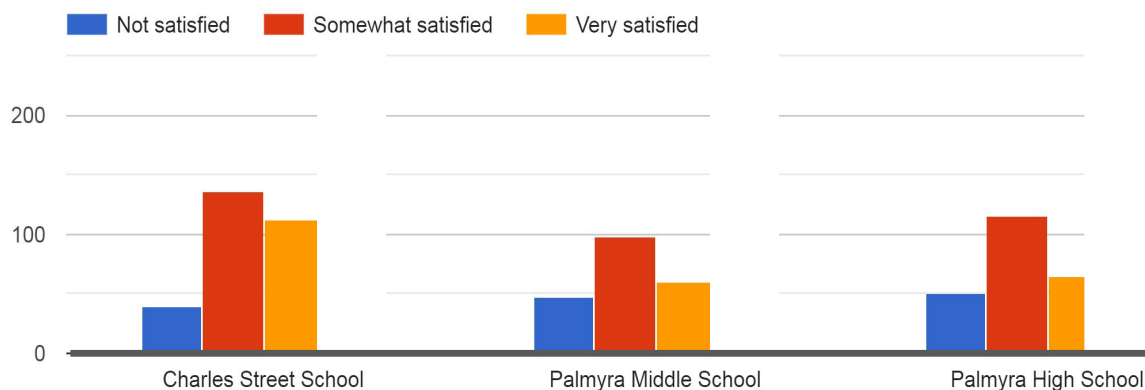

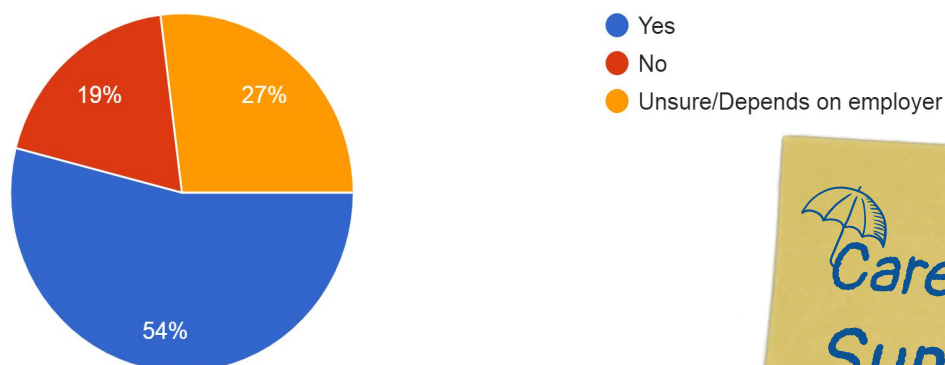
Overall, how satisfied were you with your child(ren)'s remote learning experience in the spring?

If Palmyra School District had to implement remote learning or part-time face to face learning for the next year would there be a caregiver available that could help your child(ren) with schoolwork?

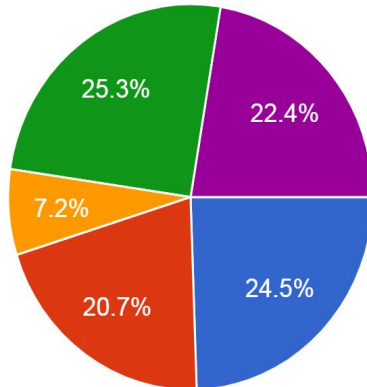

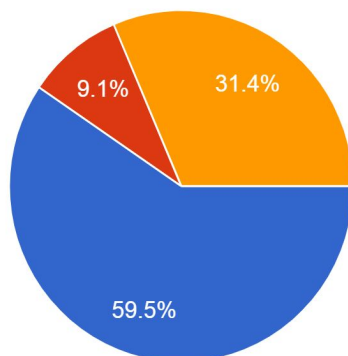
- Rotating Day Schedule (ex. Monday/Thursday or Tuesday/Friday in-person...)

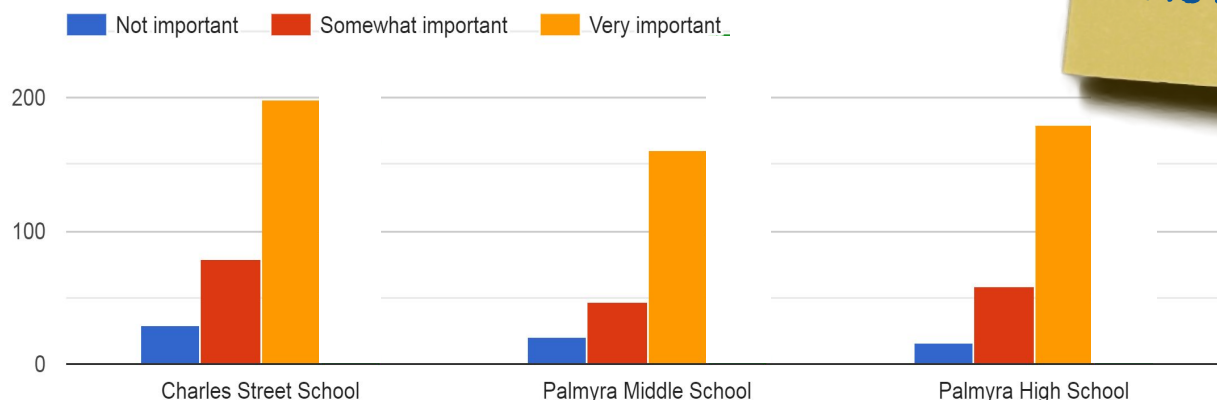

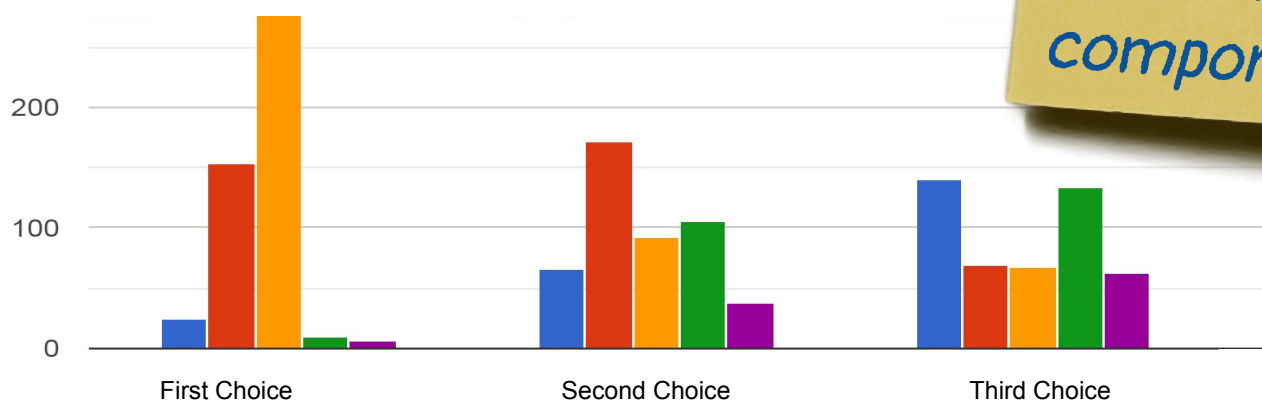
How important is live/synchronous instruction during remote learning for your child/ren?

Rank in order how important the following aspects of remote learning are to your children in terms of understanding course content.

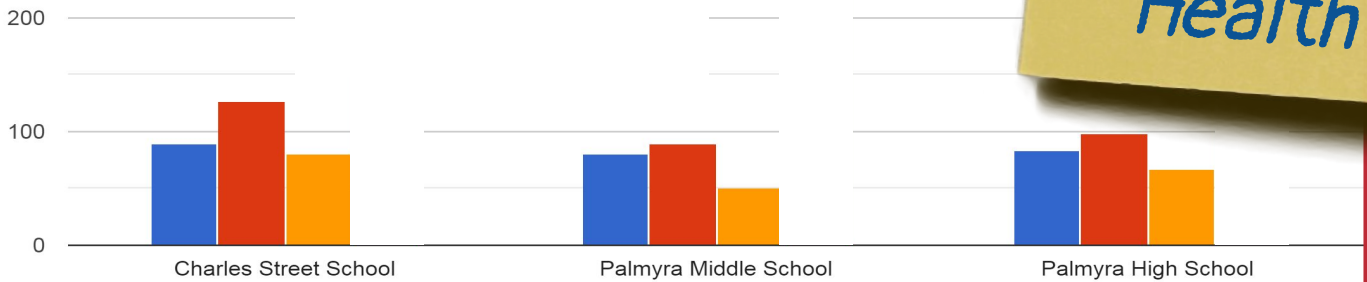

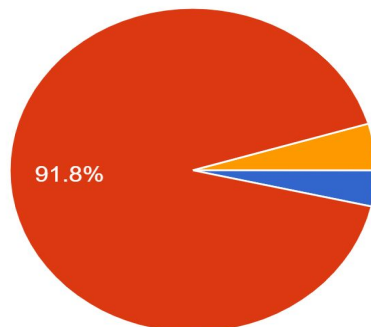

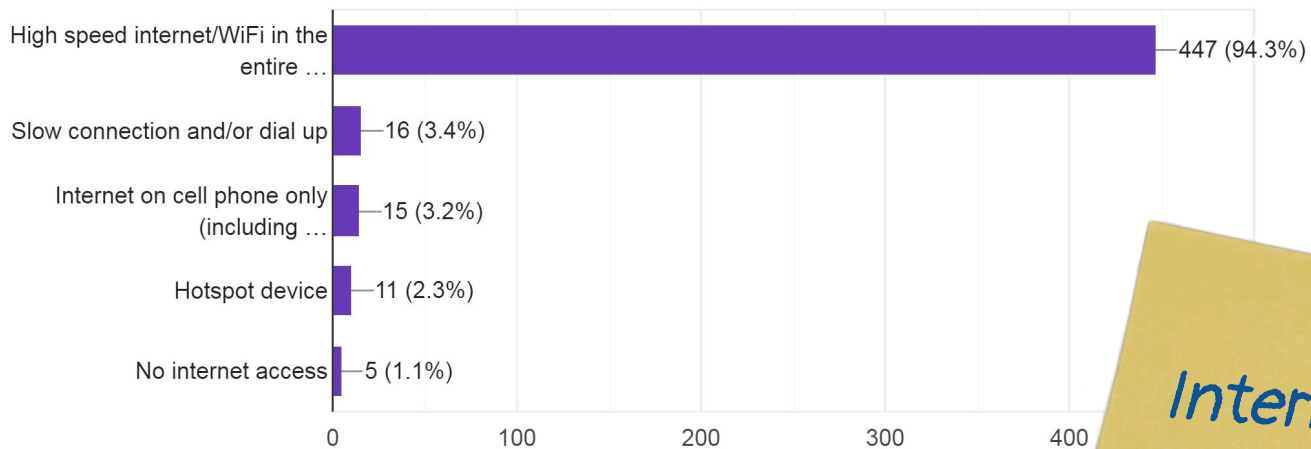

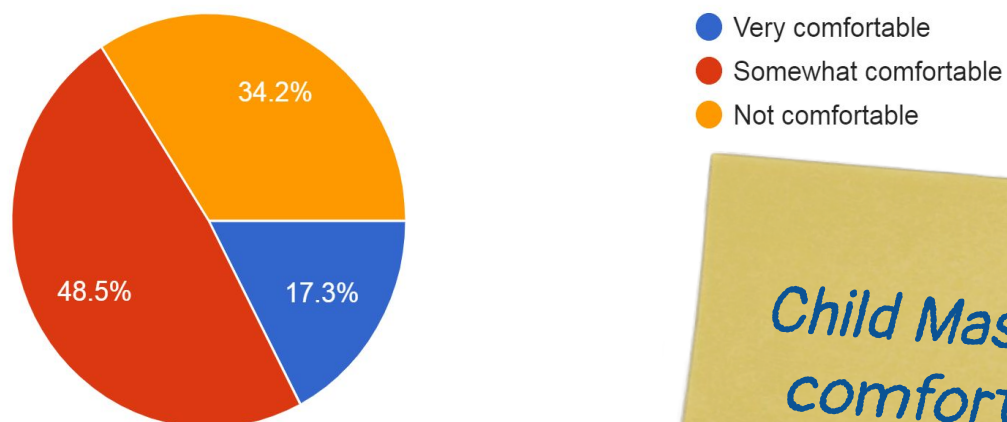


Internet Access
