

Important Parent Information

1. The beginning of school will look very different this year. Parents/Guardians will not be permitted to enter the building. Please practice with your little ones saying goodbye outside. You may want to come to school to actually practice and run through the process over and over so that on the first day, it won't be so traumatic for the kids.
2. **Lunches are to be in throw away bags.** Please make sure that your child's name is on his/her lunch bag. **All beverages have to be in disposable containers.**
3. Lunches will be placed in the walk-in cooler every day. If your child forgets his/her lunch, one will be provided for that day.
4. Students may wear their uniform shorts and polo until further notice.
5. On gym days only, students K-8 may wear basketball length shorts, a school appropriate T-shirt, and tennis shoes instead of their uniform. Shorts other than basketball length are not permitted.
6. Students will have hand washing and mask breaks throughout the day; as well as time outside each day that weather permits. This will take place through most of the winter months also as long as there is no snow on the ground.
7. **Please do not send your child to school if he/she isn't feeling well.** It is too critical of a time to risk his/her and everyone else's health.
8. We are waiting on word for sports; at this time all sports are on hold until the diocese says otherwise.
9. If/When sports resume, only students attending brick and mortar school are permitted to participate.
10. Students who are live streaming will need to be online for the entire school day as they will actually be streaming from a live in-session class. Students who pick and choose what classes to be present for will not be permitted to make up work in the classes they decided not to attend. **Live streaming attendance is mandatory just as if you were present in the building.**
11. If your child will be absent or late, please email the office to inform the attendance staff of either. The attendance email is: attendance@maryofnazarethschool.org
12. Morning drop off at the back driveway will begin at 7:30 a.m. and ends at 8:00 a.m. Parents are not permitted in the building. As students enter the building, they will have their temperature taken.
13. Morning drop off after 8:00 a.m. will be at the front of the building. Parents are not permitted in the building. As they enter the building, student will have their temperature taken.
14. Bus drop off will be in the front of the building. Students will have their temperature taken as they enter the building.
15. Bus dismissal will be from the front of the building, while car dismissal will be from the gym doors. All parents who decided on car dismissal through our survey will receive a letter with details about how that will work.

16. **Until further notice, students will not bring back packs into the building.** They will need to carry their supplies in disposable bags (i.e. Giant Eagle, Walmart, etc.) that will be discarded after emptied.
17. Students' computers will be sanitized every day when they return them to the building. I encourage you to sanitize them when they come home. Computers are issued for the entire year. **If your child breaks his/her computer, you are responsible for having it repaired or replaced.**
18. Everyone that is permitted to enter the building, will have on a face mask/face shield and will have a temperature taken.

#5 – Close Contact <u>with</u> Symptoms	Yes	Individuals should be tested for COVID-19. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If the test result is <u>negative</u>, return to school 14 days after last exposure to the person with COVID-19 and symptoms have resolved. If the test result is <u>positive</u>, follow return to school guidance for scenario #3.
#6 – Close Contact of COVID-19 <u>without</u> Symptoms	Yes	14 days after the date of last exposure to the person with COVID-19 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If symptoms develop during 14 days, follow return to school guidance for scenario #5.

#7 – Secondary Contact of COVID-19 <u>with</u> Symptoms	Yes	<p>Individuals should be tested for COVID-19.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If the test result is <u>negative</u>, return to school 14 days after last exposure to the person with COVID-19 and symptoms have resolved. • If the test result is <u>positive</u>, follow return to school guidance for scenario #3.
#8 – Secondary Contact of COVID-19 <u>without</u> Symptoms	Yes	<p>14 days after the date of last exposure to the person with COVID-19</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If symptoms develop during 14 days, follow return to school guidance for scenario #5.
