

BOARD SELECTS TWO STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES

During the January 12, 2015, Work Session Meeting, Board Members interviewed two candidates for the new Student Board Representative positions. The intent of the Board is to select one Junior each year to serve a two-year term. For the first year, the Board opened applications to Juniors and Seniors (for the selected Senior to only serve a one year term). This year, the Superintendent's Office received 4 Junior applications but only two were complete with all the required supporting material. There were no Senior applicants.

Board Members interviewed both applicants at the

beginning of the Board Meeting, asking each candidate the same questions relating to their interest in the position and their extra-curricular activities. Both applicants were highly qualified and interviewed well, resulting in the Board selecting Mr. Henry Vachon to the two year Junior position and selecting Mr. Corey Black to serve a one year term (that would have otherwise went to a Senior applicant).
