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Personnel Changes Approved for BASD Support Staff

During the Tuesday, March 15, 2016, Board Meeting, Board members voted to approve some personnel changes that will affect the Support Staff.

Included in those changes was the retirement of Mrs.

Marion Faust (pictured left), Bedford High School Food Service employee, effective March 11, 2016. Mrs. Faust had been working with the District for 23 years, beginning in 1993. Another personnel change in Food Services was the hiring of Mrs. Lisa Hillegass as a food service employee for the District. Mrs. Hillegass began on March 16, 2016, at the

Bedford Elementary School.



Additionally, Mr. Walter Beal (pictured right) was approved as the Lead Custodian for the Bedford Elementary School. Mr. Beal has been the Interim Lead Custodian for BE since the start of the school year in August, while the late Mr. Bill Duncan was out on leave. Mr. Beal has been a custodian for the District since August 21, 2007. Finally, Mr. Andy Martz was approved to fill the vacant full time custodial position at the Bedford High School. Mr. Martz will be



hired at the starting rate in the support staff contract.

The Bedford Area School District Board of Education met on February 8, 2016, for a work session, and on February 16, 2016 for a business meeting, in the Board Conference Room at the Bedford High School. Costs pro-rated between the Everett Area and Bedford Area School Districts. Estimated pro-ration: \$4316 for Everett Area; \$8764 for Bedford Area. All costs paid through 21st Century Community Learning Center grants.




IN MEMORIAM MR. BILL DUNCAN October 14, 1960 — February 29, 2016
