Motion Fails to Renew Charter Application

On January 5, 2016, during the Board Work Session meeting, the Bedford Area School District Board of Education voted on a motion of intent to renew the HOPE for Hyndman Charter School charter for five (5) years. On a 2 to 7 vote, the motion failed carry. There will be a public hearing held at the Bedford High School at a date to be determined (originally scheduled for February 10, 2016, but continued), followed by a 30-day public comment period. Once a new date has been set for the Public Hearing, information will be posted on the District website and in the Bedford Gazette.
