2016-2017 Retirements

During the May and April Board Business meetings, Board Members accepted retirement letters from several employees within the District.




Mr. Steve Waltman, Bedford High School Guidance Counselor, will be retiring effective June 6, 2017, after 29 years working for the District.

Please join the entire District as we thank these employees for their years of service and wish them the best in their retirements!


New BHS Guidance Counselor Hired



During the May 16, 2017 Board Business Meeting, Ms. Jennifer Ferraro was unanimously approved as the new BHS Guidance Counselor for the 2017-2018 school year. Ms. Ferraro most recently worked at the Salisbury-Elk Lick School District and has a Bachelor's from Frostburg State University and a Master's from California University. Join us in welcoming Ms. Ferraro to the District!

Restructuring of Tech Department

During the April Board Meeting, the Board approved for the District to restructure the Technology Department. The restructuring coincided with the news that Mrs. Judy Eller, Director of Information and Communication Technology, would be retiring effective June 1, 2017. It also aligns with some future plans the District has relating to technology in education. As part of the restructuring, leading the department will be the Director of Technology Services/Chief Information Officer. Mr. John Diehl was approved to fill this role, which is part of the Act 93 Agreement, at the May 16, 2017, Board Business Meeting.



Additionally, the restructuring led to the creation of a new position of Lead Computer Technician. Mr. Steven Harman was approved to fill this position at the May Board Meeting. Mr. Harman will be joining our current Computer Technicians, Gary Cooper and Justin Roberts, on June 1, 2017.

Also during the April 18, 2017, Board Business Meeting, approval passed for Technology Infrastructure Improvement, to be paid from Capital Reserve Fund. The breakdown of those improvements is as follows:

- (1) Presidio for wireless access points-\$188,452.50
- (2) UDNI (United Datacom Networks Inc.) for switching- \$77,250.95
- (3) UDNI (subcontracted to PA Networks) for cabling- \$78,408.00
- (4) ApplianSys for caching server- \$13,111.00

The total cost of the Project is \$357,222.45, with \$194,874.46 to be reimbursed by Erate.

Tentative Budget Approved

On a 5 to 3 vote, Board Members voted to approve a tentative budget for the 17-18 school year. This tentative approval includes:

- Projected Expenditures: \$29,988,162.00;
- Projected Revenues: \$28,794,457.00;
- Fund Balance needed to balance the budget: \$1,193,707.00.

The tentative budget also includes a millage rate increase from 9.222 to 9.526. Following tentative approval, the Board must allow 30 days to pass before they can consider and vote to approve a final budget for the upcoming school year. This will most likely take place at the business meeting on June 20, 2017.

- Approval of MOU with the BAEA concerning the Laurel Life contract.
- * Approval of Combi Oven purchase from Clark Food Services, to be paid out of the Capital Reserve Fund.
- Approval of Resolution to amend the Consortium Agreement between Reschini Group and the Bedford
 Area School District.
- * Approval of the 2017-2018 School Calendar (approved at March 21, 2017 Business Meeting), with an August 21, 2017, return date for teachers and an August 23, 2017, back to school date for students. (Calendar available on the District website.)

Act 93 Agreement Renewed

On Tuesday, May 16, 2017, Board Members voted unanimously to renew the Act 93 Agreement, effective from July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2020.
