Board Appreciation Month

January is the Pennsylvania School Board Association's School Director Recognition Month, a time to

celebrate our elected school board members who serve our students and educational system. This month during the January Board Business Meeting, the Bedford Area School District showed appreciation for our nine school board members for their time, effort,



and dedication to public education's advancement. The successes of our students are being highlighted in a PSBA statewide campaign called "PA Public Schools: Success Starts Here." School Directors play a special part in this campaign in that they set the foundation for a strong education system in our local area.

As we continue to celebrate the success stories in our schools, let's not forget our elected school directors who play a significant role in creating the environment where those successes can happen. We thank our School Directors for the special part they play in setting the foundation at the Bedford Area School District.

Assistant Superintendent's Contract Renewed

Board Members voted unanimously to approve a contract renewal for the Assistant Superintendent, Dr. Paul Ruhlman, for another five years. Dr. Ruhlman's current contract will be up on June 30, 2017. Mr. Bullington, Board President, expressed confidence in Dr. Ruhlman's role within the District. His newly approved contract is effective July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2022. In a statement from Dr. Ruhlman, he expressed, "I'm incredibly proud of the students and staff at BASD and I'm looking forward to continuing to serve them for the next five years."

Jr. High Soccer and Cross Country Programs Approved

Board Members voted unanimously to approve Jr. High Girls and Boys Soccer and Jr. High Cross Country programs to begin at the Bedford Middle School in the 2017-2018 school year. Board Members discussed some concerns over starting these programs at the Junior High level, including the impact they might have on outside soccer programs. But based on a student interest survey conducted at BMS, student interest is high, with approximately 42 boys and 44 girls expressing interested in the soccer programs.
