In compliance with TSSAA regulations, Dyer County High School is pleased to announce a plan for return to athletic contests for its sports teams. These past few months have been very challenging with the cancellation of spring sports and the uncertainty of fall sports. On Wednesday, July 22, the TSSAA released COVID-19 Sports Regulations for their member schools. With the very strict regulations for spectators, comes very tough decisions that have to be made on a local level. Your cooperation and understanding is greatly appreciated.

- In compliance with TSSAA regulations, at contests all coaches, players, team personnel, officials, administrators, and fans must have their temperatures checked before entering the facility. No one whose temperature measures 100.4 or greater may be admitted. For spectator screening areas, if a line forms or is anticipated to form, ensure 6 or more feet of separation between persons or household groups(e.g., ground markings and/or announcements).
- 2. In compliance with TSSAA regulations, at each contest the following symptom checklist shall be posted prominently at the spectator entrance(s) instructing that anyone who is experiencing any of these symptoms during the preceding 7 days must not be admitted:

 Fever Cough Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing Shaking chills Chest pain, pressure, or tightness with exercise Fatigue or difficulty with exercise Racing heart rate Unusual dizziness Loss of taste or smell Sore throat Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea Unusual rash or painful discoloration of fingers or toes
- 3. In compliance with TSSAA regulations, at contests in localities where fan attendance is permitted, Dyer County High School will limit fan attendance to 1/3 of typical seating capacity which will allow for adequate social distancing and will mark/designate bleachers or seats in order to promote social distancing among spectators. Dyer County High School must facilitate compliance with any applicable state or local order limiting gathering sizes for participation in public events. In consultation with local health providers, if the Dyer County High School area experiences a high virus transmission, we will consider further limitations on attendance (e.g., family members only, or no spectators). Limit informal gathering in areas where social distancing cannot be maintained.
- 4. In compliance with TSSAA regulations, Dyer County High School will require that all fans wear facial coverings at all times while onsite (except children under age 2) and maintain social distancing (six feet, or the equivalent of two empty seats between themselves and other fans) from anyone other than those living in the same household.
- 5. Dyer County High School will sell tickets at the gate for all athletic events with the exception of Friday night varsity football games.

In addition to the previous regulations, these are additional regulations for Dyer County High School **Varsity Football Games on Friday nights**,

- 6. Dyer County fans will need to purchase a season pass for \$30 for Friday night games only. **These passes are NON-Refundable**.
- 7. Priority of Season Pass Sales
- a. **2** per high school football player, cheerleader, and band member.

- b. 1 per Dyer County High School students
- c. 1 per General Public fan

**Schedules for the sales of season passes will be posted on DCHS website and DCHS Facebook page. Please look for this information starting Monday, August 10.

- 8. The re-sale of season passes will not be permitted on school property.
- 9. Everyone must have a season pass. No exceptions for ages.
- 10. All fans must enter at the front entrance of the stadium.
- 11. Concessions will be allowed to sell limited items.
- 12. No Tailgating
- 13. No County Passes will be accepted at the game due to capacity limitations.
- 14. TSSAA and TACA Pass will admit 1 and Championship Event Card will admit 1 person ONLY for regular season games.
- 15. Athletes from other schools must purchase a season pass.
- 16. Gate will open at 6:00pm. Early arrival is recommended
