#### 1 Call to Order

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 10:4-6, et. Seq. (Open Public Meetings Act) provides that the Palmyra Board of Education may exclude the public from that portion of the meeting at which the Board of Education discusses certain matters as set forth in N.J.S.A. 10:4-12; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has deemed it necessary to go into closed session to discuss certain matters which are exempted from the public; and

WHEREAS, the regular meeting of the Board of Education will reconvene following the end of the closed session, at approximately **8:30 pm** this evening

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education will go into closed session for the

following reason(s) as outlined in N.J.S.A. 10:4-12: Any matter which, by express provision of Federal Law, State Statute or Rule of Court shall be rendered confidential or excluded from discussion in public Any matter in which the release of information would impair a right to receive funds from the federal government Any matter the disclosure of which constitutes an unwarranted invasion of individual privacy Any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions of which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of terms and conditions with employees or representatives of employees of the public Any matter involving the purpose, lease or acquisition of real property with public funds, the setting of bank rates or investment of public funds where it could adversely affect the public interest if discussion of such matters were disclosed Any tactics and techniques utilized in protecting the safety and property of the public provided that their disclosure could impair such protection Any investigations of violations or possible violations of the law Any pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation in which the public body is or may become a party. Any matters falling within the attorney-client privilege, to the extent that confidentiality is required in order for the attorney to exercise his ethical duties as a Any matter involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment, evaluation of the performance, promotion or disciplining of any specific prospective public officer or employee or current public officer or employee employed or appointed by the public body, unless all individual employees or appointees whose rights could be adversely affected request in writing that such matter or matters be discussed in public

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the afore stated meeting shall be closed to the public for the reasons set forth above, in accordance with the OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT and that the discussion in closed session will be disclosed to the public at such time as it is no longer necessary to maintain the confidential nature of the items discussed. Upon its return from closed session the Board may take action

#### 6 Policy and Curriculum

BE IT RESOLVED, in response to the unprecedented impact of COVID-19, that the following action is hereby recommended by the Superintendent:

The Board of Education authorizes the Superintendent of Schools to take necessary actions and make decisions within regulations as a temporary change that would normally require the approval of the Palmyra Board of Education, if it is not possible to convene a Board of Education meeting within the needed time frame. All emergency actions must be reviewed and approved by the board president, vice-president and one more designated board member with board e-mail acknowledgement. This emergency authority shall continue until the September 2020 BOE meeting unless otherwise directed by the Palmyra Board of Education.
