- Choose a distraction free space to conduct remote learning
- > Headphones/earbud are recommended for videos and Google Meet sessions
- > Read, watch, or listen to the directions and work carefully
- Know when your teacher(s) will be online and ask for help and explanations if needed
- > Share work and discuss ideas with your teacher(s) and with other students, when appropriate
- > If you have difficulty submitting assignments, let your teacher(s) know
- > Ask questions if the assignment(s) is/are unclear
