GIRLS SOFTBALL

TRACK RECORDS BROKEN

This year's track team has broken several records. The boys' 4x200 meter relay Juniors Ethan Rudd, Shane Reese and Seniors Sean Lee and Jake Jones broke the record of 1:45.05, set in 2006, the first meet at Ripley (1.42.35) on March 24 and then broke their own record at New Richmond (140.29) on April 4.

FELICITY FRANKLIN FIRE DEPARTMENT

The ground was broken in December for an expansion to the Felicity-Franklin fire station. The expansion is from 2,500 square ft to about 8,500 square ft. The number of bays for equipment will grow from six to nine, and sleeping quarters for six firefighters will be built.

The sleeping quarters will be used in the future when the dept. hires full-time employees and is able to staff the station 24-hours a day. The dept. currently has two paid part-time employees and 28 volunteers. "There is no additional cost to the taxpayers. The project is being paid for with money we've saved over the years." Chief Rick Weber said. Weber said "in addition to plans for adding employees and purchasing equipment, the dept. which is a private fire company founded in 1963, are talking with the Franklin Township to merge with the township life squad". The building will be finished in May.
