NEVILLE IS STILL A VILLAGE

In March, 2016, voters in the village of Neville rejected a proposed measure to dissolve the village and become part of Washington Township. The measure was prompted by chronic financial woes. If the measure had passed, Neville's municipal property and structures, including two parks, would have been turned over to the township.

Neville, which is one of the oldest village's in the state, needs about \$16,000 to maintain operations. Currently, the village, which doesn't have any businesses, generates about \$9,000 annually through income tax, gas taxes and license taxes.

Mayor Cecil Collins, Jr. said "I hope we can keep going the way we were."

FRANKLIN TWP. FIRE AND EMS SECURES GRANTS

The Franklin Twp. Fire and Emergency Services Department recently secured \$132,953 in grant funding from the US Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency.

The grant, which requires a 5 percent match from the department, will be used to purchase 12 sets of turnout gear, two cardiac monitors with 12-lead capability used to detect heart attacks, two automated external defibrillators, a gear extractor, used to clean gear and new fire hoses and nozzles for the department's two fire engines and two water tenders.

Bradley Moore, Fire/EMS Chief, said the new cardiac monitors should be here now.

MOSCOW BICENTENNIAL

Sept. 2016, Moscow celebrated their bicentennial. The event was organized by the Moscow Historical Committee.
