

What is Collinsville Alternative School?

The Collinsville Alternative School provides support to students aged who are unsuccessful in the traditional school setting or who are at risk of dropping out of school. The primary function of the program is to provide an alternative method for students to earn the necessary credits to receive a Collinsville High School diploma.

Response if a parent requests to move to the Collinsville Alternative School.

There are a limited number of seats available for Alternative School Placement. The priority Target groups for placement in the Collinsville Alternative School are:

- Fifth Year Seniors
- Junior, and Senior students who are one or more years behind in credits needed for graduation
- Recovered dropout students
- Self-supporting/ homeless students
- Pregnant/ parenting students
- Students with a history of not being able to emotionally adjust to the regular school environment

Is there an intake and screening process to determine student eligibility for the Alternative School?
