

 Fever: at least 24 hours have passed with no fever, without the use of fever-reducing

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- Sore throat: improvement (if strep throat: do have been taken); not return until at least 2 doses of antibiotic
- Cough/Shortness of breath: improvement
- Diarrhea, vomiting, abdominal pain: no diarrhea or vomiting for 24 hours
- Severe headache: improvement
