

Announcing the School Start

Campbellsport School District has been planning with staff over the course of the summer concerning the restart of school this year. Thanks to the input from parents, staff and public health officials; we are prepared to enter this challenging time. Recognizing the uniqueness of education at each level, our plan differs for the elementary, middle and high school situations.

Although we will start in a particular stage, we are ready to move as health concerns get measured at the county, district, school and class levels. We have available outbreak measures not only from the county but the district also. Once school begins attendance of students and staff will be assessed to drive decisions. As said before this is a very dynamic, fluid situation that needs maximum flexibility and involvement by all.

In the next day or two you will be receiving a communication from your Principal with more details. On September 1, the school year begins and will look like this for each level:

- Elementary Schools (both CES and EES)
 - Students will be in school for the full week.
 - Personal Hygiene and Distancing will be applied.
 - Lunch, Recess and Classrooms will have assigned seats.
 - Masks will be required to ride the bus and throughout the building.
- Middle School
 - Students will be in school for the full week.
 - Personal Hygiene and Distancing will be applied and emphasized.
 - Students will be in Home Bases, with restricted movement during the day.
 - Lunch and Classrooms will have assigned seats.
 - Masks will be required to ride the bus and throughout the building.
- High School
 - Cohort System will be applied with half the students present each day.
 - Cohorts are currently being developed and will be communicated soon.
 - Cohort A will be present Tuesday and Wednesday the first two weeks.
 - Cohort B will be present Thursday and Friday the first two weeks.
 - Classrooms will have assigned seats. Restricted locker usage.
 - Personal Hygiene and Distancing will be emphasized.
 - Masks will be required to ride the bus and throughout the building.

At the start of the second week September 8th, as new data and experience is gathered, we will be adjusting as needed. Several communications are coming out over the next week please be looking for them.
