ALTERNATIVE LEARNING OPTIONS

HYBRID, PARENT CHOICE



In the HYBRID, Parent Choice learning mode:

- Families will meet with building administration to create a schedule for hybrid students.
- Working with building dynamics (master schedules, etc), consistent schedules will be created for each student.
- All accountability and expectations are the same as for an in-person student.
- Students commit to Hybrid, Parent Choice for 9 weeks at a time.
- Available Pre-K-12.
- Transportation outside of normal bus routes will not be provided by USD 375.

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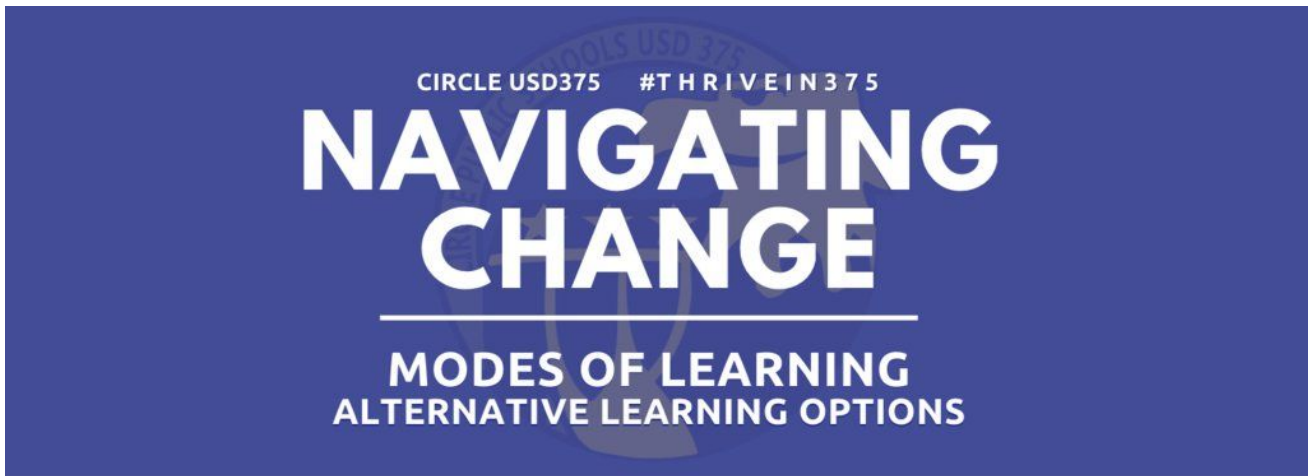
CMS

We think the options that work the best for CMS Students are:

Students have to log 6 hours or 360 minutes a day when not Onsite

- The student attends courses that are more difficult to take if not present in the classroom due to a high level of hands-on learning. The rest of the week is Remote learning.
- Courses offered for Hybrid are:
 - 7th grade Electives: (students have already picked with pre-enrollment) Choir, Band, Jazz Band, Explorations in Art, Maker Space, Robotics, Explorations in Science, Strength & Conditioning
 - 7th grade Required: Project Lead the Way (1st semester), Introduction to Industrial Technology (2nd semester), and Physical Education.
 - 8th grade Electives: (students have already picked with pre-enrollment) Choir, Band, Jazz Band, All Art classes, Maker Space, Robotics, Explorations in Science, Strength and Conditioning, Physical Education.
 - 8th grade Required: Flight and Space
- Elective Classes that can be taken through Remote are: Leadership, Real World & History through the Movies.

- Core Content classes will be offered through Remote: Math, ELA, Science, Social Studies, Business Essentials/Computer Application (8th grade only), Health (8th grade only)
- Classes taken in person will count as part of the 360 minutes per day requirement.



REMOTE, USD 375 TEACHER



In the REMOTE, USD 375 learning mode:

- Your student has the opportunity to receive all instruction from Circle teachers, at home.
- This mode will provide a natural transition to in-person learning when desired.
- Student learning is monitored by a USD 375 staff member & daily telephone or teleconferencing communication is required.
- Requires a 9 week commitment.



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CMS: This remote option will allow students to receive instruction from their CMS classroom teacher(s). Hands-on classes (electives) will be modified for remote learning.

Students have to log 6 hours or 360 minutes a day when not Onsite and in person contact through google meet or phone conversation will occur daily with assigned CMS teacher.

*Students who are typically an Onsite student - might stay home because they don't feel good, and they can log on in order to not be counted as absent for the day. Communication between office and classroom needs to occur to help this documentation.

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REMOTE, EDGENUITY



In the REMOTE, Edgenuity learning mode:

- You may choose a pre-existing, online curriculum for your student.
- Students in grades K-12 will receive instruction via the Edgenuity curriculum program.
- Student learning is monitored by a USD 375 staff member & daily telephone or teleconferencing communication is required.
- Students commit to Remote, Edgenuity for a semester at a time.

Daily communication required with student / CMS teacher through google meets or phone call.
